

PUBLIC NOTICE

TO THE PROPERTY OWNERS AND RESIDENTS OF CARROLLTON TOWNSHIP

Act No. 359 of Public Acts of 1941, as amended, provides that:

It shall be the duty of all owners of land on which noxious weeds are found growing, to destroy the same before they reach a seed bearing stage and to prevent such weeds from perpetuating themselves.

Weeds not destroyed by **May 1, 2011**, unless an extension is obtained due to wet conditions, will be cut by a representative of Carrollton Township. Further, all properties must be continually maintained and kept free of weeds or the Township will cut the weeds as many times as is necessary.

All expenses incurred in the destruction of such weeds shall be paid by the owner of the land and until paid, the Township shall have a lien upon such land which shall be enforced in the same manner as any other tax lien. In addition, any owner who shall refuse to destroy such noxious weeds as provided by said act shall be subject to a civil infraction citation.

As provided for in P.A. 172 of 1969, this Public Notice is published in lieu of the Notice by Section 4a of P.A. 359 of 1941, as amended.
