- Show concern for an injured player, regardless of team.

### UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR

- Disrespectful or derogatory yelling, chanting, singing or gesturing.
- Booing, heckling or displays of extreme temper over a coach's decision.
- Use of profanity or displays of anger that draw attention away from the game.

# CARROLLTON RECREATION LEAGUE RULES AND REGULATIONS

## COACHES

- Every player must play a minimum of 8 minutes (one quarter)
- There will be 8 minute quarters with a running clock.
- Clock will stop in the last 2 minutes of the fourth quarter for any whistle if the game is within 10 points.
- Each team will get 2 timeouts per half (1 minute each)
- Player that displays poor sportsmanship (arguing, cursing, etc.) will be benched for one quarter immediately. If it occurs in the fourth quarter player must sit the rest of the game.
- If behavior persists, player will be ejected from the game and may have to sit out the next game upon the recreation board's decision.
- Teams are only allowed to full court press in the last 2 minutes of the game.
- The clock will be set for 5 minutes for overtime games.
- The five players that are on the court when overtime occurs, are to be on the court for that full overtime.

### Remember:

This league is for the players to have fun and learn how to display good sportsmanship. Coaches: please keep in consideration that the referees are high school students and are not official referees. They will miss calls and make bad calls once in a while. If you have a complaint please fill out a complaint form after the game to express your opinion. Do not argue or display poor sportsmanship. Remember your players are watching!
