There being a full board, Supervisor Kozara called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Also in attendance: Police Chief Craig Oatten, Fire Chief Tom Czerniak, DPW Superintendent Mark Pilkington and Assistant Office Manager Megan King.

Public Hearings:

Robert Gubody, 3562 N. Monroe, questioned why the public hearings were not posted on the outdoor signs. Kozara explained that it was an oversight and that the public hearings were posted on the front door, the township website and the newspaper. Kozara asked Pilkington to make sure future meeting dates were posted on the outdoor signs.

1. Trash Collection Operating/Maintenance Special Assessment District:

For fiscal year 2006-2007, the budgeted amount needed for expenditures, other uses and contingencies was \$478,697. It would require a 2006 tax levy of \$90.08 per housing unit.

2. Fire Operating/Maintenance Special Assessment District:

For fiscal year 2006-2007, the budgeted amount needed for expenditures and other uses was \$545,459. It would require a millage levy of 2.5 mills on the Taxable Value for real property.

Public Comments: None.

3. Police Operating/Maintenance Special Assessment District:

For fiscal year 2006-2007, the budgeted amount needed for expenditures and other uses was \$1,261,497. It would require a millage levy of 7.471 mills on the Taxable Value for real property.

It was moved by Riley and supported by Dalton to adjourn. There being all ayes, the meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
