VII Fee Clarifications

ITEM # 17, MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE:

When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites.

When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor.

When setting a HUD mobile home or a Premanufactured home on a private property, a permit must include the application fee, service feeder.

IX Instructions for Completing Application

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the **job location** and **permit number**.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED**

WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
