V. APPLICANT SIGNATURE

VII. FEE CLARIFICATIONS

ITEM #2, MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE: When item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. When setting a mobile home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Bureau of Construction Codes. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the **job location** and **permit number**.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR RE-INSTATED.**
